Post Combustion Capture Conference



At IEAGHG, we have established ourselves as organisers of some of the most influential international conferences on CCS. Having recently delivered the successful GHGT-16 in Lyon, France with more than 1200 attendees, we are now embarking on the organisation of the 7th Post-Combustion Capture Conference (PCCC-7).

The IEAGHG event will be co-hosted by one of our members, the United States Department of Energy (USDOE) via its National Energy Technology Laboratory (NETL), and will take place from 25-27 September 2023 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania USA. A field trip to visit a local capture-related facility is likely on 28 September.

The event is anticipated to attract around 180-200 attendees and will involve top academics and industry professionals at the heart of post-combustion capture development and deployment. The event is intended to offer the latest developments in post-combustion CO₂ capture, updates from the major international capture test centres, reports from demonstration facilities, as well as from commercial CCS plants currently in operation.

To ensure we can keep our delegate fees affordable, we will have a small number of sponsorship opportunities available to support this not-for profit conference as well as exhibition space.
